At a glance

Strictly necessary cookies may operate without consent because they are required for the website to function. Optional analytics, advertising, social-media, or similar tracking technologies must remain disabled until the visitor gives a freely given, specific and informed consent. Visitors can change or withdraw their choices through the Cookie Settings control.

1. Purpose and scope

This Cookie Policy explains how BioPath Innovations S.A. ("BioPath Innovations", "we", "us" or "our") uses cookies and similar technologies when visitors access the public website at www.biopathinnovations.gr and its English and Greek pages. It should be read together with the GDPR & Data Protection Statement.

Separate portals, including authenticated client or HPC services, may use additional essential cookies and may be governed by separate privacy information presented within those services.

2. What cookies are

Cookies are small text files stored on a computer, smartphone or other device when a website is visited. They allow a website to remember information about a visit, such as language choice, security status, session information and consent preferences. Similar technologies may include local storage, pixels, tags and scripts.

3. How we use cookies

- to provide core website functionality, page navigation, security and load management;
- to remember the visitor's language and cookie preferences;
- to support authenticated WordPress administration or restricted portal sessions, where applicable;
- to understand website usage through optional analytics, but only after valid consent;
- to enable third-party or embedded content only when the relevant optional category has been accepted.

4. Cookie categories

Category	Purpose	Consent position
Strictly necessary	Required for security, navigation, session management, language selection and storage of cookie preferences.	Always active where technically necessary; no consent is requested.
Functional	Remembers optional choices or enables enhanced features that are not strictly necessary.	Activated only with consent, unless a particular feature is explicitly requested by the visitor.
Analytics	Helps measure visits, traffic sources, page performance and general use of the website.	Disabled by default and activated only after consent.
Advertising / social media	Supports advertising, profiling, social-media integrations or cross-site tracking.	Disabled by default and activated only after consent. BioPath Innovations does not rely on these technologies unless specifically enabled.

5. Current first-party cookie register

The following entries describe the cookies normally required by the present WordPress and multilingual configuration. Exact technical names can change following a plugin, theme or security update. The live Cookie Settings panel should be kept synchronised with the active website configuration.

Category preference cookies (for example, necessary / non-necessary selections or equivalent)	BioPath Innovations / consent-management plugin	Stores category-specific consent choices.	Up to 12 months	Strictly necessary
Language preference (for example, a WPML or Polylang language cookie)	BioPath Innovations	Remembers whether the visitor selected English or Greek.	Session to 12 months	Strictly necessary / functional
WordPress test, session and security cookies	WordPress	Checks whether cookies are supported and protects authenticated sessions. Primarily relevant to administrators or logged-in users.	Session; some settings up to 12 months	Strictly necessary
Analytics cookies, if an analytics service is enabled	The analytics provider identified in Cookie Settings	Produces website-use statistics and performance information.	As shown in Cookie Settings	Analytics - consent required
Embedded-content or third-party cookies, if enabled	The relevant third-party provider	Loads external media, maps, social content or other integrations.	As shown in Cookie Settings	Functional or advertising - consent required

6. Consent and cookie controls

When optional cookies are used, the first visit should display a cookie banner that provides equally clear options to accept, reject or customise optional categories. Optional technologies must not be placed before the visitor has made a positive choice.

- Consent can be changed or withdrawn at any time through the Cookie Settings link available on the website.
- Withdrawal does not affect processing that was lawful before withdrawal.
- Rejecting optional cookies does not prevent access to the basic website, although certain optional features may not work.
- Consent should be requested again when purposes or providers materially change, or after the configured renewal period.

7. Browser controls

Visitors may also use browser settings to delete or block cookies. Blocking all cookies may affect language selection, forms, login functions or other essential features. Browser controls do not replace the website's obligation to obtain consent before using non-essential cookies.

8. Third-party services and international transfers

Some optional services may be supplied by third parties. Their cookies and processing practices are governed by their own notices. Where a provider processes personal data outside the European Economic Area, BioPath Innovations will use an appropriate transfer mechanism and supplementary safeguards where required. The current provider and transfer information must be displayed in the Cookie Settings tool or the GDPR & Data Protection Statement.

9. Changes to this policy

This policy may be updated when the website, consent platform, providers or legal requirements change. The effective date and version number will be updated. A technical cookie scan should be performed after material website changes and at regular intervals.
